- Building and Ground Worker: \$66,692

School & Custodial Supplies:

Resources for Students & Parents:

- Curricular Trips: \$3,000
- Advisory Committee Expenses: \$3,000
- Contracts for Academic Supports: \$10,000

- Tutor Teacher X-Time: \$15,000
- Professional Development Teacher X-Time: \$25,000
- Administrator X-Time: \$10,000

- Staff Conferences: \$5,000
- Instructional Coach (Math): \$115,897

The school also has \$301,577 of carryover funds from last year to spend this year.

The school must "use it or lose it" so tell your Principal how to spend the money to support high need students!

Beginning in the 2017-18 school year, the Community Coalition v. LAUSD lawsuit settlement provides \$150 million of additional funds to 50 middle and high schools in Los Angeles over 3 school years to invest in resources and programs that support high need students.
