- Supplemental Instructional Material: \$30,000
- Custodial Supplies: \$5,295
- General Supplies: \$30,000

- Administration X-Time: \$60,000
- Program Advisor X-Time: \$10,000

The school also has \$856,287 of carryover from last year to spend this year. The school must "use it or lose it" so tell your Principal how to spend the money to support high need students!
