Below is a list of how the Principal plans to spend \$1,041,330 in the 2018-19 school year:

Positions:

- College Counselor: \$77,266
- AVID Auxiliary Teacher: \$10,010
- Office Technician: \$44,254
- Restorative Justice Advisor: \$77,266

Resources for Students & Families:

- College Visits: \$12,000
- Curricular Trips: \$12,000
- Software Licenses: \$20,000
- Technology/Equipment: \$441,735

Professional Development & Pay for Staff:

- Technology Support Teacher: \$74,583
- Teacher Tutor X-Time: \$3,000
- Counselor X-Time: \$6,982
- Day-to-Day Substitutes: \$7,440
- Staff Conference Attendance: \$35,000
- Teacher X-Time for Professional Development: \$89,021
- Tutor Teacher X-Time for AP Support: \$3,000

School Supplies:

- General Supplies: \$40,000
- Instructional Materials: \$1,500

The school also has \$543,446 of carryover funds from last year to spend this year.

The school must "use it or lose it" so tell your Principal how to spend the money to support high need students!

Beginning in the 2017-18 school year, the Community Coalition v. LAUSD lawsuit settlement provides \$150 million of additional funds to 50 middle and high schools in Los Angeles over 3 school years to invest in resources and programs that support high need students.
