- Restorative Justice Teacher Advisor: \$115,897
- Psychiatric Social Worker: \$121,023
- Los Angeles Education Partnership Community School Coordinator: \$50,000

Resources for Students & Families:

- Software Licenses: \$25,000
- Parent Education Bridge for Student Achievement Foundation Trainings: \$3,984

Professional Development & Pay for Staff:

- Professional Development Contract: \$61,220
- Teacher Pay for Professional Development: \$20,000
- Teacher X-Time for Common Core Planning Time: \$15,000
- Professional Development to Support English Learners: \$8,373
- Social/Emotional Skills Training for Staff (\$12,480) (\$2,920) & 8 Substitute Teachers: \$15,400

School Supplies:

Chrome Book Carts: \$48,000

The school also has \$495,640 of carryover funds from last year to spend this year.

The school must "use it or lose it" so tell your Principal how to spend the money to support high need students!

Beginning in the 2017-18 school year, the Community Coalition v. LAUSD lawsuit settlement provides \$150 million of additional funds to 50 middle and high schools in Los Angeles over 3 school years to invest in resources and programs that support high need students.
