

For All Students

Charter schools are publicly funded and must admit all students who wish to attend provided there is space.



Equal Opportunity to Attend

If space is limited, then a random public lottery must be held by the school to select its students.

Preferences can be given to students who live near the school or whose siblings currently attend.

Know Your Rights



May Not Exclude

Students with disabilities, academically low-performing students, English learners, and those impacted by the criminal justice system cannot be excluded.

No GPA Requirement

Policies cannot require a student to have or maintain a certain grade point average (GPA) to be admitted.





Immigration Information is Protected

Schools cannot require families to provide birth certificates, passports, or social security numbers to admit their child.





No Parent Volunteer Requirement

Charter schools must be free of charge. Schools cannot require parents or guardians to volunteer time or donate money as a condition of their child's admission.
