Bail Order

19 The Court has considered the bail application for class member [REDACTED]
20 [“the Class Member”], together with the moving and opposing papers.
21

22 The Court finds that the Class Member has established that his case is
23 extraordinary, involves special circumstances, and has a high probability of success.
24 *See Land v. Deeds*, 878 F.2d 318, 318 (9th Cir. 1989); *United States v. Dade*, – F.3d
25 –, 2020 WL 2570354, at *2 (9th Cir. May 22, 2020). The Court, further, finds that
26 the Class Member has established, by a preponderance of the evidence, that he will not
27 be a flight risk, will not be a danger to public safety, has a stable location to reside
28 while released, and has transportation available to that stable location.

1 **It is Ordered** that the bail application be, and hereby is, **Granted**.

2
3 **It is further Ordered** that Respondents shall release [REDACTED]
4 from custody within 48 hours of the filing of this order, and he shall remain released
5 pending further order of this Court.

6
7 **It is further Ordered** that the Class Member shall comply with all of the
8 following conditions of release:

- 9 1. The Class Member shall reside at the residence submitted to the Court in the
10 Class Member's bail application ["the Approved Residence"].
- 11 2. The Class Member shall be transported from the Adelanto Detention Center
12 ["Adelanto"] directly to the Approved Residence via the method, and by the
13 person, submitted to the Court in the Class Member's bail application.
- 14 3. The Class Member shall self-quarantine at the Approved Residence for 14 days
15 after being released from Adelanto. The Class Member shall not leave the
16 Approved Residence during the quarantine period, except to obtain medical care,
17 including COVID-19 testing. However, the Class Member need not stay in
18 quarantine for the full 14 day period if he receives, after being released from
19 Adelanto, a negative test result for COVID-19. If the Class Member exhibits any
20 potential COVID-19-related symptoms, he shall immediately seek appropriate
21 medical care.
- 22 4. The Class Member may not move from the Approved Residence to a different
23 residence without first obtaining prior approval from the Court.
- 24 5. The Class Member shall obey all applicable pandemic-related shelter-in-place
25 orders, regulations, and protocols issued by local, state and/or federal
26 governments.
- 27 6. The Class Member shall not possess or consume illegal drugs.
- 28 7. The Class Member shall not violate any federal, state or local law.

1 8. The Class Member shall not possess any firearm, destructive device, or other
2 dangerous weapon.

3 9. The Class Member shall submit to location monitoring, as directed by
4 Respondents, and shall comply with all location monitoring rules imposed by
5 Respondents, provided that those rules are given to the Class Member in writing.
6

7 **It is further Ordered** that the Court may modify or revoke this bail order if
8 the Class Member violates any of the above conditions of release.
9

10 **It is further Ordered** that Respondents shall not arrest or re-detain the Class
11 Member without first obtaining an order from this Court.
12

13 **It is further Ordered** that this order does not limit Respondents' authority to
14 remove the Class Member from the United States upon the issuance of a final order of
15 removal.
16

17 **It is further Ordered** that Respondents shall provide the Class Member with
18 a copy of this bail order at the time of release.
