**Subject:** POST AB 392 Course Now Available

Good afternoon Region 9 Partners,

The long anticipated AB 392 “bolt-on” course is now ready for distribution and use by presenters. A POST PASS message is forthcoming but in the meantime, here’s a little info for you.

This course may be built and used as a stand-alone 2-hour course OR added on to an existing course (hence “bolt-on”). The CCN is 33888.

\*Note: If you choose to use the bolt-on option, you will need to submit a separate course roster for the 2 hours in order to ensure proper CPT credit for this course in EDI. (Submit one roster for your UoF course, and another roster for this AB 3922 course.)

This course is designed to be used in conjunction with the LTR video, *AB 392: California’s New Use of Force Standard, What You Need to Know*. The LTR video can be viewed as a standalone through the Learning Portal and will immediately be reflected in EDI as having been viewed. However, CPT credit will only be given for completing the 2-hour instructor-led course (a portion of which includes the video). Be advised, the Learning Portal is getting slammed, so it’s been slow as of late, but that will lighten up over time with less use and get back to normal.

The ECO should be available online through the AB 392 page of the Law Enforcement Resources section of the POST website shortly. However, I am attaching a copy here for you who wish to get started right away and don’t have enough work with SB 978... 😊
