

SUBJECT: Fraud Detection and National Security Priorities

I. Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to update the guidance provided in the June 20, 2008 memorandum entitled, "Fraud Detection and National Security Priorities". This guidance is necessary because of evolving national security and fraud concerns, increasing caseloads, and altered FDNS field governance agreements.
