



 - · Authority to vet/adjudicate non-KST cases with the field
 - Supervisory concurrence before final adjudication of cases involving NS concerns
 - Senior-level concurrence required before a NS case may be approved
 - · Standard recording of actions and findings of NS concerns
 - · Collection of statistics for data and trend analysis



- Identification of National Security (NS) Concern
- Internal Vetting/Eligibility Assessment
- External Vetting
- Final Adjudication

- NS Concern exists when an individual or organization has been determined to have an articulable link to prior, current, or planned involvement in, or association with an activity, individual, or organization described in sections 212(a)(3)(A), (B), or (F), or 237(a)(4)(A) or (B) of the INA.
 - Terrorist Activity
 - Espionage
 - Sabotage
 - Illegal Transfer of Goods, Technology, or Sensitive Information

Non-Known or Suspected Terrorist (Non-KST) NS Concern

 A category of cases with NS concerns, regardless of source, including but not limited to associates of KST(s), unindicted co-conspirators, terrorist organization members, persons involved with providing material support to terrorists or terrorist organizations.

Ex. Arrest by DOD as Suspected Insurgent: KST or Non-KST?

 Individuals and organizations who fall into the Non-KST grouping may also pose a serious threat to national security.







- Articulable link: An articulable link exists when two things are connected in a way that can be explained
- Articulable is defined as capable of being expressed, explained or justified
- Information may be from the application, interview, system checks, or other sources
- Must consider totality of the circumstances
- Does the information allow a reasonable inference to be drawn as to the connection?








 - Precludes lengthy vetting if statutory grounds for denial exist

- If it is a HQ CARRP referral, where would you document this on the assessment?




